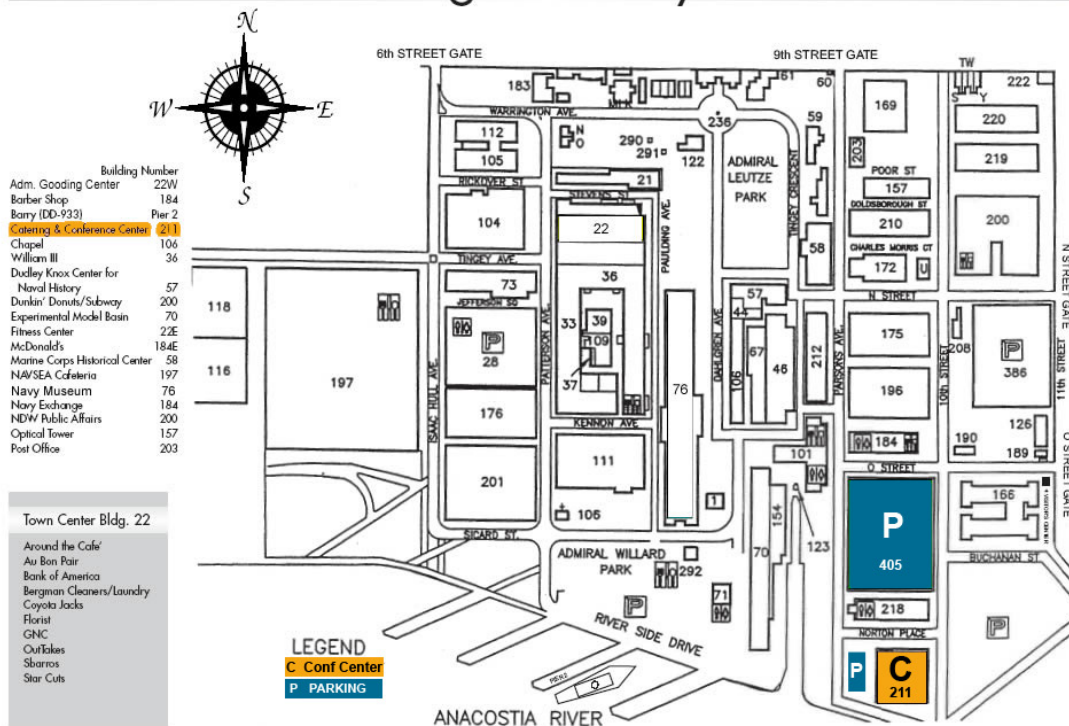

### Directions:

**Note:** Guests must be pre-registered, have proper ID, and all vehicles must have current registration and insurance to enter the Navy Yard to attend Industry Day Programs. Pre-registered names will be made available to all gates by Conference Center staff.

**By Metro:** Take the Green Line to the Navy Yard metro stop. Allow sufficient time to walk to the 6<sup>th</sup> Street Gate for security check-in. Proceed a few more blocks south then east to the Conference Center.

**By Car:** From points North: Take 295 South to Suitland Parkway exit. Follow to 295 North. Exit at 395/Washington Navy Yard. Follow Navy Yard signs to "M" Street. Please use the "O" Street visitors' entrance off of 11<sup>th</sup> Street if your vehicle does not have sufficient decals. Otherwise, use 9th & M Street entrance. From points South: Take 395 across the 14th St. Bridge. Bear right over bridge and continue to 6th St. SE / Washington Navy Yard exit. Take exit ramp until it intersects with 8th Street, SE. and make a right on 8th St. Follow 8th St. to "M" St. SE and make a left. Please use the "O" Street visitors' entrance off of 11<sup>th</sup> Street if your vehicle does not have sufficient decals. Otherwise, use 9th & M Street entrance.
